

## Important Things To Know To Prepare For Your Upcoming Ultrasound

1. Please arrive at least ten minutes prior to your ultrasound appointment time so both the ultrasound tech and the physician remain on schedule.
2. If you arrive late for your appointment, you may be asked to reschedule your appointment.
3. Family and friends are welcome to watch the ultrasound with you however we cannot provide child care so please have someone with you who can attend to small children.
4. If you would like a gender reveal included with your ultrasound, please notify the tech before the ultrasound starts.
5. Please remember that the ultrasound is a very complex diagnostic test used primarily to evaluate the well-being of your baby, as well as an opportunity to determine gender and obtain pictures.
6. Following the ultrasound, a board certified Obstetrician will review the finding and images with you.
7. A DVD and pictures of your baby will be given to you when you have your 20 week ultrasound. We will provide you with the best pictures possible however sometimes the position of your baby or other issues can affect the quality of the images.
